Please remember, completion of Hazardous Weather Training is now a required course for all direct-contact leaders (Cubmasters/ACMs, Den Leaders, Scoutmasters/ASMs, Crew Advisors/Associate Advisors). At least one adult leader on a hiking or backpacking event should have completed the Trek Safely course. At least one adult leader on a swimming event should have completed the Safe Swim Defense course. At least one adult leader on a boating event should have completed the Safety Afloat course. At least one adult leader on a climbing event should have completed the Climb On Safely course. All leaders are encouraged to complete the Drive Safely course. Always print or download your completion certificates; save these in case of technical glitches in recording your training.
