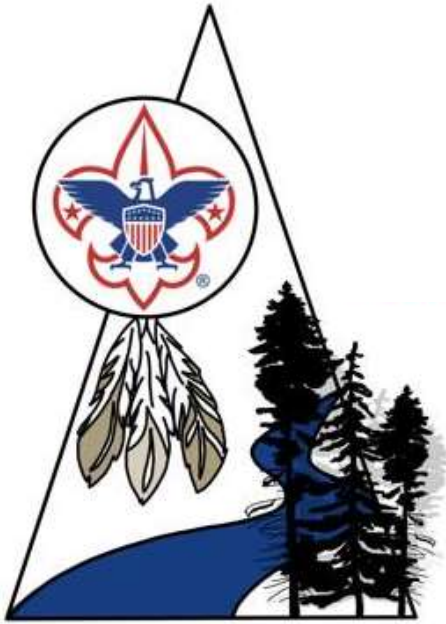


Every Scout Deserves a

- Units should request the training far enough in advance to allow the training staff to effectively prepare the event
- The requesting unit will host the event, providing space and facilities appropriate to the course and its usual three-hour time frame
- The requested training course will remain open to all other units
- The requesting unit(s) should be able to guarantee at least seven (7) participants (working with neighboring units is encouraged)
